

THE GRACE MODEL: TAPPING INTO YOUR WINNING POTENTIAL

Focal point:

"For if, by the trespass of the one man (Adam), death reigned through that one man, how much more will those who receive God's abundant provision of grace and of the gift of righteousness reign (as kings) in life through the one man, Jesus Christ." (Romans 5:17)

"You have made them to be a kingdom and priests to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth." (Revelation 5:10)

Overview:

In this breakthrough lesson, we will look at the secrets to tapping into Grace from a Kingdom perspective and unlocking its rich and unlimited power. It's time to see Grace as a Kingdom concept and learn how its authentic strength can empower you to serve as a royal Ambassador and government official of Heaven in the earth. In fact Grace is the power that enables you to serve in and fulfill the roles of your Heavenly office.

You have been endowed with an abundance of Grace, to meet every need (spiritually, physically, emotionally and financially) and to excel and thrive above and beyond any capacity. Quite plainly, there is greatness within you that Grace is trying to get out! The nature of God is wrapped in His grace, hidden deep inside of you ready to explode. In fact that Grace is really power or "potential" dealing with great force and explosiveness.

So much that the word dynamite in English derives from the exact Greek word for power "dynamis." Power should not just be looked at as strength, but explosive strength, that when tapped into can release the right potential to thrust anyone into a level of dominance and mastery in their respected field and calling in life. In order to benefit from Grace as much as possible, you have to create the right mentality. You must become aware of it's presence within you, actualizing it, drawing from it's abundance and boldly place a demand on the royal life God placed inside of you through his son. Recognition of Grace can do this and cause you to really tap into the spiritual giant within.

God didn't put you here to be ineffective and only make an impact between four walls. No. You have a Grace, tailor made for you, assigned to you to give you provision to meet every calling, vision and purpose with the provision and resources of Heaven's throne. That's why Grace has been used in so many different ways in

the bible. It's all of the benefits that flow from being rightful heirs connected to the throne of Heaven. Heaven is your jurisdiction legally; you have the right to draw from its unlimited rank to supersede any principality of this cursed world and to rise above its limitations. That's how you master tapping into your winning potential, because the Grace of kings is a winning mindset that cannot be interrupted with limited self-perceptions that flow from the influence of this world's system. As long as you have Grace you are never limited. You need to know this because daily you are facing attacks against your Grace. In other words, Satan has influenced the systems of the earth with a strategic plan to create disorder and dysfunction in your family, job, business, emotions etc. by trying to pump information and earth cursed principles through media, music, books etc.

These earth cursed philosophies exist to remind us how limited we are. That we can't pursue things greater than ourselves and that somehow where we are is all there is and God can do nothing else with us. Don't allow these attacks to weigh in on your Grace. You have the right to function in kingship and royal authority. I don't care what it is, speak to it. I don't care who laughs, speak to it. Be mindful of your power position, draw from that Grace and make declarations that would shake the nations. Make announcements that would tingle the ear of those who heard them. Draw from Grace, don't be timid and don't approach God with fear.

If you understand this "free gift" of Grace, you will tap into your heavenly nature or "righteousness in Christ." Here you will realize you aren't responsible for your righteousness, Jesus is. You literally were simply divinely appointed to receive His Grace, tap into His abundant strength and leverage it as a powerful system to win at all times in life. Win in your mind and overcome thoughts of condemnation, you are not saved by works, you are saved by Grace; the unlimited benefits and total benefits package of the redemptive works and sovereign purpose of the Cross. Grace is that purpose, that power and that redemption.

You're entitled to greatness and rulership in this earth. Now when you die and enter heaven, now, as it is in Heaven shall it be in the earth. Get ready for a perspective on Grace you've never seen, and prepare to draw from its unlimited abundance and power to tap into the "rights of the Son" so that you can leverage His purpose to reign as a king in this life and the next.

LESSON 8 CURRICULUM

- I. Reigning in Life: 6 Steps to creating a winning mentality
- Kingdom Paradigm: Have you created or developed within you the perceived value you possess and how much you are worth to God?
- 1. Understand your value: Who are you and what do you have?
- a. Gain understanding of the richness of your royal inheritance that gives Blessing spiritually and materially. Inheritance tells you who you are by examining what you have. The greatest struggle and obstacle hindering Christians' effectiveness in this earth and their ability to influence is they lack an understanding of their meaning and value as royal heirs to the entire Kingdom and estate of God, the supreme eternal creator and King. So let's tap into Grace by clearly defining whom you really are as dominator in the Kingdom of God.
- b. Who are you? (Your identity)
 - i. A Son of God; in the Kingdom of God (Romans 8:15)
 - ii. A King and a royal Priest in God's Kingdom. (Revelation 5:10)
 - iii. A Supernatural being cut out of the fabric of God's nature and image. (Genesis 1:26)
 - iv. A royal Monarch [Dynastic/generational ruler] (Daniel 4:3)
 - v. A legal beneficiary and inheritor of the Blessing of Abraham; Abrahamic Contract (Galatians 3:13-14)
 - vi. The Ecclesia, the royal congress or law-making and enforcing body of Jesus Christ in the earth realm. As far as earth is concerned you are the representative of Heaven.
 - vii. A heavenly ruler (Ephesians 2:6)
 - viii. Courageous, bold, and mentally conditioned (2 Timothy 1:7)
 - ix. A person of massive influence (Matthew 5:14)
 - x. God's favorite (Ephesians 1:6-8)
 - xi. A Champion (2 Corinthians 2:14)
 - xii. A leader (Joshua 1:2)
 - xiii. A visionary (2 Corinthians 5:7)
 - xiv. A gatekeeper; legal enforcer and executer of Kingdom law and justice (Matthew 16:19)
 - xv. A dominator (Joshua 1:3)
 - xvi. A thousand strong (Isaiah 60:22)
 - xvii. Wealthy (2 Corinthians 8:9)
 - xviii. UNLIMITED (Philippians 4:13)
- c. These are a few scripture verses that you should be meditating on daily to gain the right perception of yourself and to see that value you hold through your place in the Kingdom. You are divine royalty, both God and man combined, that makes you a supernatural hybrid being. You can have influence in the Heavens and the earth realm too, that's why you are seated with Christ in heavenly places. That's a double portion of Blessing, bread= earthly possession and wine= spiritual inheritance or Heavenly possession: you've been given heaven

as your inheritance and then planet earth as your inheritance and possession (Ephesians 2:6) (Psalm 2:8).

- 2. Actualize the Grace that's in you
- a. You must take time to look inside your treasure chest and examine what you have inherited through God's will. This will is full of blessing both tangibly and immaterially, and it is your divine right to leverage both to create successful ways, winning habits and an excellent lifestyle. Lets look inside:
- b. What do you have? (Your inheritance)
 - i. Authority
 - ii. Power
 - iii. Influence
 - iv. Diplomatic Immunity
 - v. God's life in you
 - vi. Access to Heaven's abundance
 - vii. An inheritance
 - viii. Redemption
 - ix. The mind of Christ
 - x. Faith of God
 - xi. Dominion
 - xii. Doors of opportunity
 - xiii. A king and a priest's anointing
 - xiv. Earthly authority
 - xv. Spiritual dominion
 - xvi. Land, property, real estate
 - xvii. Houses
 - xviii. Gold, silver, diamonds
- 3. Gain an attitude of forcefulness: What's your is yours?
- a. "The Kingdom suffers violence and the violent take it by force." Forcefulness is the key to getting the Kingdom to work for you all the time. You have to continually place force on it, work it and demand from God what your inheritance has afforded you. One way we talked about applying force is through the application of spiritual laws. Another way we can apply force by our attitude and the consistency we apply in seeking out Kingdom truth to continually apply to our lives.
- b. Stop being passive: You will never get anything from God nor will you experience the benefits of your unlimited inheritance living your life to please others and stay in the box. Too many people are not comfortable in their own skin so they sell themselves short in life entertaining any relationship and connecting with people who don't support their dreams or vision. A forceful attitude will always speak truth and say what needs to be said regardless of who will walk away. That's taking authority; by planning and building relationships based on real Kingdom strategy you are forcing Kingdom benefits to be unleashed.
- c. Characteristics of a forceful attitude
 - i. Keeps asking God until he answers

- ii. Pursues the Kingdom relentlessly (reads books, listens to Kingdom sermons, prays the Kingdom in daily confessions and meditates on the Kingdom within)
- iii. Is not concerned with an adversary and understands victory is in the royal inheritance. Therefore does not accept injustice and stands on the Word of truth no matter the circumstances until it comes to pass
- iv. Does accept no for answer when pursuing any vision God has given
- v. Does not spend time having pity parties and soaking over past negative events
- vi. Recovers quickly and recognizes every failure as a strategy to become great
- vii. Watches daily with expectation for spiritual things to manifest and for dreams & words to become realities
- viii. Confident in the Kingdom lifestyle and will never abort its way of living regardless of pressure
- ix. Is driven by the intents and purposes of God's heart
- x. Understands the Kingdom is now.
- xi. Understands they have the right to win, accelerate and dominate, therefore will not relent in their pursuit of an excellent life.
- 4. Create an attitude of gratitude: Leveraging praise to power progression
- a. Focus on Kingdom progression: What you focus on in the process to achieving your dreams will determine your overall state of mind, attitude and perspective of your progress. It is your responsibility to combat negative and pessimistic thinking with a real and actual attitude of thanksgiving. What are you thankful for? Take your pick: life, health, opportunity, vision and destiny etc. These are things to constantly fill up on to refuel your drive on the journey to success.
 - i. Remember that the Kingdom of God is love, joy, peace and righteousness in the Holy Spirit. That means the royal governor wants to influence your emotions and thoughts as much as he wants to create breakthrough in your tangible life. Allow him to work through you and to harmoniously-work-in both areas of your life, bringing them together with positive life generating thoughts and principles that can enrich and encourage your heart as you strive to achieve greater levels of excellence.
- b. Be accountable to your progression by taking some type of action everyday to bring your dreams to fruition: A very important Kingdom principle that follows Kingdom expansion or advancement is the principle of migration. Migration means movement. In order to have dominion you have to move you can't be still in a now season you have to look for doors to walk through. Peter was a fisherman, so when he walked on water it was God telling us, you can have dominion in your sphere of influence if you are ready to move and step out no matter the time or season. You need to train your ear to hear God's instruction and be ready to be mobile at any time. Simply put, you have to move; everyday on the road to achieving your dreams take some kind of action. Be honest and ask yourself several questions at the end of each day:
 - i. Did I steward my time today?

- ii. Am I closer today than I was yesterday to accomplishing my goals?
- iii. What can I do tomorrow to ensure things are different than today?
- iv. Why? Why not me? Why not now?
- c. Examine what you drives you: The big WHY? Now is a great time to begin asking yourself an important question: what drives me? What is your cause, the big reason you are doing what you're doing? You need to know, because if you're WHY is not big enough, you will give up in the process. Your WHY is the only thing that justifies the turbulence you're experiencing as you pursue what God has laid on your heart. Write that WHY down, visit it regularly and let it become a launching pad from which inspiration, great ideas and big leaps of faith draw their capacity to launch.

5. Embrace and invite change:

- a. A real cause will bring real change: Embrace it.
 - i. Change ends in a new season. A change in season begins with a change in the atmosphere. A change in the atmosphere begins with a sign in the sky (Ex: precipitation change, sky color changes, or night comes faster). In order to embrace change you need to know how and when change begins, and it starts with signs. Jesus told the Pharisees about being able to interpret signs of seasons (Matthew 16:1-3).
 - ii. When you step out on vision from God, you are stepping into a new season and time. Things are always subject to change with one courageous act of faith.
 - iii. Look for new people, examine old relationships and evaluate who you will keep in your life in this new season and who has to go.
 - iv. Even without—a new vision you can create a shift, by speaking new things. By faith declare you are receiving new vision and new vision will come. Don't wait for the change, pursue and embrace it.
 - v. Be open to new people, places and things as God desires to help you fully transition through the change. That's the importance of breakthrough teaching as we discussed earlier.
 - vi. A real cause from God inspired by a real WHY, is going to bring radical shifting, expect, accept it, embrace and walk in it.

6. Choose God's best vs. what's good

- a. Faster: Your seasons are sure to accelerate when you begin to rise above your wants and gravitate towards God's best. You are a miracle waiting to happen and many times people miss their breakthrough blessing because they are hindered by the comfort of familiarity.
 - i. Don't let change be paused or delayed because you only desire what's good. Be determined to pursue God's best, because as King he is only going to instruct you on the most favorable outcome. This means things may not always come when we want them, but be reassured, God will bring them in the fullness of time, to position you for the most favorable outcome.

Reigning through your inheritance: Possessing the Kingdom of God

- The power of an inheritance
 - 1. A deserved right: Everything you possess in the Kingdom of Heaven is yours; there are no if, ands, or buts about it. It's not an earned right; it is an inherited right that comes through the dynasty bloodline of Jesus Christ. That's called favor. It is a gift unmerited full of benefits and blessings. Christ deemed us worthy not on our own behavior or good works but as a result of His finished work. We are not here to do God's job, the Holy Spirit's job or Jesus' job, we are here to fulfill a vital role and assignment as executives of the planet which is to spread the culture of the invisible Kingdom across the Globe, inheriting the earth as our possession and ruling it as God rules Heaven. So, you earned it, not by your works but on the account of Christ's redemptive work. Your job is to gain understanding of why you're here and that answer is simple: To take divine authority over the earth's systems of influence and delegate this authority to other individuals who are going to teach the same authority to people everywhere. The earth is your inheritance, and also the heavens are your inheritance too. You have a "double" portion blessing.
 - 2. Recovering the Eden lifestyle: God's provision package restored
 - a. Eden vs. Babylon (cursed world) The benefits of your royal inheritance received goes on and on. However the major principles are clear and definitive of God's intent. The difference between life in Eden vs. life in Babylon is that Eden is the place or spiritual city where God meets all provision for the man. In Babylon, this cursed world system gives man the burden of his own provision. You were never created to be controlled by money; you were always supposed to be money, control money and make money. Mentally we can reclaim that lifestyle through revelation knowledge of God's Word and Kingdom patterns to institute and implement Eden's provision package.
 - 3. Not cursed, Blessed: The Blessing is on YOU
 - a. If you ask God he will give you the earth as your inheritance and possession (Psalm 2:8). There is no more curse on you; begin tuning your Spirit to how the Kingdom can impact you now.
 - Your inheritance is a Grace that allows you to pull from your provision and possessions in Heaven and from a covenant that God blessed us with in this earth.
 - ii. Awareness of Grace is revelation of royalty through the inheritance. It's time to rule the earth, as kings appointed to live without limits.
 - iii. Study the Word and find as many scriptures as you can on the inheritance. Study, realize it and pursue it, you have an already accomplished win in your life.

Other important keys to walking in your inheritance

You're the architect of your life. How should you build your life? That is the most important question. Build it based on what God says you ARE in His Word. This is a Kingdom mindset:

- 1) Build according to who God says I am.
- 2) Build according to my realized inner purpose.
- 3) Everything I do, is with purpose and intent.

So what does God say about YOU?:

1. Creating a healthy paradigm

- a. Take a moment to review the previous class about what's in the inheritance.
- b. Ephesians 1:18

I pray also that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in the saints

- ➤ His call is his vision, his purpose & intent, his plan, his will, his inheritance, his Kingdom, his estate, his hope, his destiny and expected end- All this is his pleasure. But Paul says you need to be enlightened to walk in this glorious inheritance or destiny.
- The key to walking in God's predesigned destiny is a paradigm and a change in your view of yourself, your life and how you view God- He is King, a father with a will, inheritance and estate.
- 2. <u>How a Kingdom Paradigm can release unlimited blessing</u>
 To live above the limits you must:
- a. Change and then increase your value of life (time, relationships, destiny)
 - o What do you do that devalues life?
 - o How do you waste time?
- b. Build faith in the inheritance
 - i. Through the Word (find scripture)
 - ii. Meditate, utter aloud, declare, change language systems
 - iii. Block out negative voices
 - iv. Realize it's his pleasure to give it to you
 - v. Become a person of commitment; commit to seeking out & living in your inheritance and God-designed destiny
 - vi. Begin making new commitments now
 - vii. Create 20 core life principles you'll never change based on the Word and Kingdom teaching
- c. If you see yourself broke will you get wealthy? If you see yourself sick will you get healthy? If you see yourself as a slave/servant will you get to experience life as a son?
- d. We all know the answer is no.
 - i. Even with all the knowledge if you don't change your view you lose! It's important to commit to changing the way we view ourselves. Let's destroy the negative self-picture. Paul addresses that picture, when he says "the eyes of your heart be enlightened."
- Paul suggests what keeps us out of the inheritance is our view of our value and self worth which bleeds into time, relationships, and destiny. In order to increase value, cut out things we do or think to devalue ourselves.

4. 9 Things we spend our life doing

- 1. We spend 51 days deciding what to wear
- 2. Half a year watching TV ads
- 3. 6 whole weeks waiting at traffic lights
- 4. Two weeks wondering what happens after death
- 5. 30 years fast asleep (1/3 your life in bed) at least 90 YRS)
- 6. 7 months having sex
- 7. One and half years looking for things you can't find
- 8. Over two weeks peering inside the fridge
- 9. 67 days heartbroken

Devaluing life is the main issue as to why many people don't experience happiness.

Who means the most to you? If it depended on their life, could you find a way to achieve your goals?

❖ 8 Things that are a waste of time & interrupt a healthy self image:

- 1. Comparing yourself to others
- 2. Complaining about the past
- 3. Blaming others
- 4. Wanting change but not doing anything
- 5. Slandering other people
- 6. Be a pessimist instead of an optimist
- 7. Being inconsistent in faith, dreams etc.
- 8. Living your life (to please) based on what others think

5. Building faith in the inheritance

- a. Meditate on the Word. Decree, confess, talk about it, etc.
- b. Leviticus 20:24 But I said to you, "You will possess their land; I will give it to you as an inheritance, a land flowing with milk and honey." I am the LORD your God, who has set you apart from the nations.
- c. Numbers 14:8 If the LORD is pleased with us, he will lead us into that land, a land flowing with milk and honey, and will give it to us.
- d. Deuteronomy 6:3 Hear, Israel, and be careful to obey so that it may go well with you and that you may increase greatly in a land flowing with milk and honey, just as the LORD, the God of your ancestors, promised you.
- e. Deuteronomy 26:15 Look down from heaven, your holy dwelling place, and bless your people Israel and the land you have given us as you promised on oath to our ancestors, a land flowing with milk and honey."
- f. Deuteronomy 26:9 He brought us to this place and gave us this land, a land flowing with milk and honey; Deuteronomy 26:8-10 (in Context) Deuteronomy 26 (Whole Chapter)

- g. Deuteronomy 11:9 and so that you may live long in the land the LORD swore to your ancestors to give to them and their descendants, a land flowing with milk and honey.
- h. Ephesians 1:8-10 With all wisdom and understanding, he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment—to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ.
- i. Luke 22:30-32 For the pagan world runs after all such things, and your Father knows that you need them. But seek his kingdom, and these things will be given to you as well. Do not be afraid, little flock, for your Father has been pleased to give you the kingdom. Sell your possessions and give to the poor. Provide purses for yourselves that will not wear out, a treasure in heaven that will never fail, where no thief comes near and no moth destroys. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
- j. He works all things in conformity with his good pleasure; that pleasure is to give us the Kingdom, our inheritance, making us beneficiaries of his will, which again is to give us the entire estate of his Kingdom. He wants us to live out of the richness of our inheritance, where he makes all provision, both materially (Earthly) and spiritually (Heavenly).
 - i. Jesus lived out of that inheritance. In order for faith in the Kingdom to really work for us, we have to gain the total understanding and revelation that God has already set it in place. What we are releasing faith for is done; it's already finished.
 - ii. We have inherited all of his goodness, we only need to remain in faith, speak what he says, and do not waver in his promises. It doesn't matter what see, feel or think.

❖ Become a person of commitment

12 Commitments for tapping into the inheritance:

- Stop viewing God as a religion and view him as King
- Do not only seek God, seek his purpose and intent (heart)
- Learn what's in the inheritance and meditate on it (day and night)
- Stay consistent with what's in the promises and his Word and do no let just anything come out of your mouth
- Cut off negative people, doubtful and unbelieving voices no matter who or where they may be coming from
- Begin viewing yourself as son not a subject
- View God's promises as done and stop asking like God hasn't done it
- Declare and decree the word when you pray
- Rest and Relax knowing it is all inherited on Christ's merit, not your works
- Release your faith when negativity arises, do not let the Word depart from your mouth
- Begin seeing yourself as whatever you want now, rich, healthy, thin, emotionally stable etc.
- Commit to teaching someone the same thing and how to release it in their life

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
